

## Why?

Sometimes young people go through a difficult period in their lives; get in to trouble, excluded from school, suffer family breakdowns and do things they may regret in later life. They and their parents/carers need to be able to make decisions about how they will tackle these issues, put them right and what support they will need to do that. The YISP can help!



## How?

YISP will work with the young person and their family, on a voluntary basis, in partnership as a multi-agency panel in each District agencies. An initial request for service is usually supported by an e Caf or CAF, or other information, which outlines



the young person's needs. (Please feel able to ring and discuss) This is then verified by the YISP Manager and if accepted, YISP will build on the information by undertaking an ONSET assessment - all assessments include the views of parents/carers and young people and are shared with them.

The YISP panel is given the information and, together with the young person and their family, can agree how to give support. Packages of support will be offered across services that are appropriate for each situation. This can include support to parents and the family. Referrals will need to be prioritised by need.

The chart overleaf, showing the priority group, identifies that this is a **preventative service** working with those at risk of getting involved in trouble and or anti social behaviour.

YISP will usually work with a young person and family for three to six months and progress will be reviewed on a regular basis with them, their family and the other agencies involved. Ideas from the community are welcome.
