

To travel on the bookable door to dorset journeys you need to register your details with the booking line. Then, when you want to make a journey ring them up to arrange a pick up time, at the latest, one hour before you aim to travel. The booking line is open from 8.30am to 5pm, Monday to Saturday. The details overleaf show the expected departure times and the latest arrival times in the town centres and will be confirmed at the time of booking along with your pick up time.

Remember: If there is a timing point shown you do not have to book your journey. If there is a 📞 symbol a booking must be made.

Monday to Friday journeys are mainly provided by Sureline Buses. They run to a fixed timetable. There is one **d2d** journey in each direction.

Saturday journeys are provided by **d2d** service D11 in the area shown. These journeys are **bookable** except where timing points are shown.

If your village is not shown on the map or mentioned overleaf please telephone the booking line - they may be able to help you. The service is operated by NORDCAT on behalf of Dorset County Council.
