TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER VARIOUS ROADS SANDFORD WAREHAM

DORSET COUNTY COUNCIL has made a Temporary Traffic Management Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984, as amended. The order is needed in order to comply with Health and Safety Regulations, which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to Highway Users. **It will come into operation on the 8th October to 18th November 2007, a period of 6 weeks.** But it will remain in force for 18 months and can be extended, with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport, if necessary.

This Order will allow Dorset County Council to carry out major carriageway reconstruction and resurfacing works.

The effect of the Order is as follows;

For the duration of this order an advisory diversion route will be sign posted and in operation to avoid the works entirely and is as follows; from just south of Sandford Bridge proceed southward along the A351 Sandford Road to Northport roundabout. Take the second exit off the roundabout and continue to the next roundabout. Take the second exit off this roundabout onto the Bere Regis Road and proceed northward out of Wareham to Woodbury Cross junction with the A35. Turn right onto the A35 and continue eastward to Bakers Arms roundabout. Take the third exit off the roundabout and proceed southward along the A351 to the Holton Heath roundabout. The reverse route applies.

Phase 1; Monday 8th to Sunday 21st October 2007, from just south of Sandford Bridge to a point just north of the junction with St Helens Road a distance of approximately 1,200 metres.

[A] To closure the B3075 Morden Road from at its junction with Sandford Road [at the roundabout] to Forest Edge Road a distance of approximately 100 metres. There will be no direct access to Wareham from the A35 at Morden Park Corner along the B3075. A chicane will be constructed below the Forest Trail at Sherford Bridge.

[B] For this phase of the works, the Gore Hill one way order will be rescinded and Gore Hill will become 2-way.

[C] For this phase of the works, a temporary 7.5 tonne weight limit will be imposed upon Gore Hill.

[D] For this phase of the works, 2-way temporary traffic signals and stop and go boards will be used to regulate the traffic on the A351 Sandford Road through the site.

Phase 2; Monday 22nd October to Sunday 28th October 2007, from just north of the junction with St Helens Road to Sandford Middle School roundabout, a distance of approximately 400 metres.

[A] For this phase of the works, 2-way temporary traffic signals and stop and go boards will be used to regulate the traffic on the A351 Sandford Road through the site.

Phase 3; Monday 29th October to Sunday 11th November 2007, from Sandford Middle School roundabout to the Organford traffic controlled junction, a distance of approximately 1,300 metres.

[A] For this phase of the works, this section of the A351 Sandford Road will be closed and all traffic must follow the advisory diversion route. Access for individual residents within the closure area will be by arrangement with the site agent.

Phase 4; Monday 12th November to Sunday 18th November 2007, from the Organford traffic controlled junction to Sandford Road, Blackhill Road roundabout, a distance of approximately 300 metres. [A] For this phase of the works, 2-way temporary traffic signals and stop and go boards will be used to regulate the traffic on the A351 Sandford Road through the site.
